Storing the stands

To collapse and store the stands be sure to move one stand toward the other before you loosen the collar to release the tension on the extended pole. Then just reverse the deployment instructions to collapse the stands.

Adding Sand to the GawkStopper

Unscrew the sand cap and add approximately 3.5 qts. of **dry** sand. Open the leg below the hole to keep sand from getting inside the leg.

Replace the sand cap when finished. Close the leg to the collapsed position.

Attaching the tote

Take two key rings and attach one to the hole at the base of the stand and the other to the hole at the top of the base. Use the holes to the left of the handle.

Then attach the tabs on the tote, one to the top and one to the bottom key ring.

Place the ground stakes & asphalt nails in the front pocket on the tote.

Follow the instructions for folding the tarp and then place it inside the tote.

Attaching the Bungee balls & Carabiners

Lay the tarp out with the reflective chevrons face down. Locate the top right corner and place a bungee ball through the hole so that the red ball is on the blank side of the tarp, and then clip on the green carabiner. Place a bungee ball on the left top corner and a red carabiner. Repeat the process with the bungee balls and silver carabiners in the remaining holes.

Folding the Tarp for Storage

Have two people fold the tarp by taking the top of the tarp in one hand and the bottom of the tarp in the other hand. Fold the tarp at the seam so that the seam is now the bottom. Then fold that section up to the top of the tarp. Fold the tarp one more time, bottom to top.

Then have one person bring their end to the other; repeat this step one more time keeping the tarp as even as possible. Roll up the last section to form a tight roll, keeping the green and red carabiners side by side.

Place the tarp inside the tote with the red and green carabiners at the top. Snap closed.

Deploying the GawkStopper

Place one stand on the ground. Place the second stand approx. 9 ft. to the right of the first stand. Press the button on the side of the bracket to release the leg, so that it will lock into the open position. Push the button at the top of the extended leg and extend the inner leg until it snaps into place. Repeat this process with each remaining leg.

Open the snap on the tote and pull out the tarp attaching the green carabiner to the top hole on the stand to the right when facing traffic and the red carabiner to the top left stand. Continue attaching the silver carabiners in their corresponding holes.

Loosen the collar on the stands and extend the pole until the tarp is up. Tighten down the collar to keep pole extended. Pull the stands apart to tighten the tarp.

If windy stake down the stands: To use the asphalt nail, hammer it straight down catching only one hole and when using ground stakes hammer at an angle to catch both holes in the legs.
